If you are a UK tax payer by completing the Gift Aid section below the SSBA can claim 25p from the government for every £1 you pay now or in the future, so please complete the below declaration.

The extra funding raised from your gift aid will allow the SSBA to continue with its aims and securing the future of our breed.

Please note that to be eligible for gift aid you must be a UK tax payer, have paid enough tax to cover the fees and importantly must pay the membership fees as an individual and not as a business. If you claim a tax deduction for your membership fees (as part of any farm or business accounts for example) your payment is ineligible for Gift Aid.
